32 Count, 4 Wall Line Dance, High Beginner

Music: "Montego Bay" by Bobby Bloom (*CD One Hit Wonders*) **NEW!!** Re-recorded specially for me by Glenn Rogers!

Dance starts with vocals after 16 count intro

1-8 RIGHT SHUFFLE, LEFT SHUFFLE, ROCK, STEP, RIGHT 1/2 TURN SHUFFLE

1&2 Shuffle forward R, L, R

3&4 Shuffle forward L, R, L

5,6 Rock forward on R, recover weight to L (starting 1/2 turn right)

7&8 Shuffle forward R, L, R (completing 1/2 turn right)

9-16 TOUCH, TOUCH, LEFT SAILOR with 1/4 TURN, KICK, CROSS, BACK, SIDE, CROSS

1,2 Touch L toe forward, Touch L toe to side

3&4 Step L behind R while turning 1/4 left, Step R to side, Step L to side

5,6 Kick R forward, Cross R over L (R is weighted)

7&8 Step back on L, step R to side, Step L forward and across R

17-24 SIDE ROCK, CROSS SHUFFLE, WALK, WALK, & TOUCH, & TOUCH

1,2 Rock to right on R, Recover weight to L

3&4 Cross step R over L, Step L to side, Cross step R in front of L (body will be turned 1/8 left)

5,6 Step forward on L, Step forward on R

&,7 Step L to side (&) (turn 1/8 to right to square off to wall), Touch R heel to L instep (7),

&,8 Step R to side (&), Touch L heel forward (8)

25-32 WEAVE RIGHT, SYNCOPATED WEAVE RIGHT, TOUCH & CLAP

1-4 Step L behind R, Step R to side, Step L forward and across R, Step R to side

5,& Step L behind R, Step R to side,

6,& Step L forward and across R, Step R to side

7,8 Step L behind R, Touch R toes next to L instep & Clap

BEGIN AGAIN

Ending: You do not need to do this if you use Glenn Rogers version of the song. When this dance debuted at the 2004 Marathon the class decided to sing the ending! It makes it really fun! The original Bobby Bloom song ends with a waltz. So...as the music is slowing down you should be facing 12 o'clock and slow down counts 5-8 of **Section 9-16** (Kick, Cross, Back, Side, Cross). This is where you can sing "Oh what a beautiful morning..."
