4 Wall Intermediate Line Dance, 40 counts
West Coast Swing (LineDanceSport Level 2)
Music: "Texas" by Chris Rea from the album "Road to Hell" – start on vocals

Count	Steps
	Sugar Push With Anchor Step (1C)
1,2	Step forward R, L
3&4	R up behind L in 3 rd position, Step L in place, Step R back (shuffle step)
5&6	L in back of R in 3 rd position, Step R in place, Step L in place (anchor step / shuffle in place)
	Extended Right Turn (6C)
1,2	Step R forward, Step L forward & turn 1/2 R keeping weight on L
3&4	Step R back, Step L next to R, Step R forward (R coaster step)
5,6	Step L forward & turn 1/2 right, Step R in place
7,8	Step L forward & turn 1/2 right, Step R in place & turn 1/2 right
9,10	Step L back, step R back
11&12	Step L in back of R in 3 rd position, Step R in place, Step L in place (anchor step / shuffle in place)
	English Cross (5B)
1,2	Step R forward, Step L forward
&,3,4	Turn 1/4 left and step R to right side, Cross step L over R, Turn 1/4 right & step R forward
5&6	L shuffle in place turning 1/2 right (L,R,L)
	Thompson's Turn (10)
1,2	Step R forward & turn 1/4 right, Step L back
3&4	Kick R forward, Step R next to L, Step L forward & turn 1/2 left
5&6	Step R back & turn 1/2 left, Step L forward & turn 1/2 left, Step R back
7&8	Step L behind R in 3 rd position, Step R in place, Step L in place (anchor step / shuffle in place)
	Jazz Touches (Variation of step 7C)
1,2	Step R forward, Step L forward
3&4	Kick R forward, Step R back with ball of foot, Cross L over R (lock)
&5	Step R back, Touch L to left side
&6	Step L next to R, Touch R to right side
&7	Step R next to L, Touch L to left side
&8	Step L next to R, Touch R to right side
	End of Combination – Repeat from Beginning

Note: If you learn the LineDanceSport school figures for levels 1 and 2, then your entire step description for this dance would look like this:

Sugar Push with Anchor Step (1C)
Extended Right Turn (6C)
English Cross (5B)
Thompson's Turn (10)
Jazz Touches (Variation of 7C) – would have to be written out
